Please can we remind you that all children need to have a pair of wellies at pre-school. Warm coats and hats are essential too. Your child is outside a lot of their day- whatever the weather!

Please can we ask parents and carers to ensure that children's toys from home, remain at home or left in the car and not brought in to Pre-school. This causes extra sharing issues, as well as losses and breakages. We are happy for children to bring comforters though if needed.

Invoices should now all be paid and any additional days should be given in an envelope with the child's name on. Thank you.

The Co-op store in St Austell has kindly picked us again for funding. Great news! Last year they allowed us take part in bag packing and collecting with buckets which raised almost £2650 for the Pre-School!! Watch this space-and we will let you know how you can get involved.

Friday 16 November is all about Children in Need. Please dress your child in spotty clothes and bring a £1 donation. All proceeds from the School and Pre-School go to the BBC Children in Need Charity.
